

DRIVERS CPC PERIODIC TRAINING PROGRAMME FOR 2021

Plan ahead and book now for your Drivers CPC Periodic Training for 2021. All drivers who hold Cat C1 & D1 or above must undertake 35 hours of JAAPT Approved periodic training running up to the expiry date of their existing Drivers CPC Qualification Card if they want to drive for hire and reward.

Below are the dates for the TTS JAAPT Approved Driver CPC courses which will be held 2021. All our courses and trainers are registered and approved through the National Logistics Academy (NLA). Courses can be delivered remotely or in classroom. Course dates are as follows:

8 th – 12 th February 2021	2 nd – 6 th August 2021
15 th – 19 th March 2021	13 th – 17 th September 2021
12 th – 16 th April 2021	4 th – 8 th October 2021
10 th – 14 th May 2021	1 st – 5 th November 2021
14 th – 18 th June 2021	6 th – 11 th December 2021
5 th – 9 th July 2021	Last Saturday of every month

(These dates may be subject to change due to requirements of awarding bodies; additional dates maybe added)

The 5-day classroom-based courses will cover the following:

- Tachometer (Drivers Hours) (Mondays) (LGV & PCV)
- Keeping you and your load Safe (Tuesdays) (LGV ONLY)
- Staying in the green (Eco-driving) (Wednesdays) (LGV & PCV)
- Who's in your blind spot (VRU) (Thursdays) (LGV & PCV)
- Protecting the brand (Fridays) (LGV & PCV)

(The program may vary month to month please confirm the specific sessions you are attending when booking)

We also run a 2 day **Transport Manager Refresher** course that also counts as two sessions of Periodic training. Contact the admin team for further details.

Key points to remember when booking:

- Make sure you are eligible to attend and upload Drivers CPC Training
- Ensure how many qualifying sessions you have already done as you cannot "bank" sessions
- Check your hours by clicking the following link: www.gov.uk/check-your-driver-cpc-periodic-training-hours
- Do you want to complete the full 5 sessions in one week?
- If you have already done some qualifying sessions, you may not be able to repeat sessions

When attending classroom based courses you:

- You must arrive at 7.45am for registration
- You **must** be in possession of your current driving licence card
- You must attend the session for the full 7 hours, till approx. 4.00pm
- You must be prepared to participate fully in all the activities of the day
- You must complete a course evaluation form to complete the course

When attending remote/online courses you must also:

- Access to a suitable device with Wi-Fi connection, camera, microphone facility and Microsoft Teams
